Item 7.01 Regulation FD Disclosure.

As previously reported, on January 7, 2005, Torch Offshore, Inc. (the "Company") and its wholly owned subsidiaries, Torch Offshore, L.L.C. and Torch Express, L.L.C., filed voluntary petitions for reorganization under Chapter 11 of

the U.S. Bankruptcy Code with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Louisiana (the "Bankruptcy Court") to facilitate a restructuring of their debt. The cases were consolidated for the purpose of joint administration and were assigned cased number 05-10137. The Company continues to operate its business as debtors-inpossession under the jurisdiction of the Bankruptcy Court and in accordance with applicable provisions of the U.S. Bankruptcy Code.

On February 25, 2005, the Company and its wholly owned subsidiaries filed their monthly operating reports for the period January 8, 2005 through January 31, 2005 with the Bankruptcy Court (collectively, the "Monthly Operating Reports"). The Monthly Operating Reports are on an unconsolidated basis and therefore not comparable to the Company's previous annual and quarterly reports. A copy of the Monthly Operating Reports is furnished hereunder as Exhibits 99.1, 99.2 and 99.3 to this Form 8-K.

Cautionary Statements Regarding Financial and Operating Data

The Company cautions investors and potential investors not to place undue reliance upon the information contained in the Monthly Operating Reports, as they were not prepared for the purpose of providing the basis for an investment decision relating to any of the securities of the Company. The Monthly Operating Reports were not audited or reviewed by independent accountants, are as prescribed by applicable bankruptcy laws, and are subject to future adjustment and reconciliation. There can be no assurance that, from the perspective of an investor or potential investor in the Company's securities, the Monthly Operating Reports are complete.

The Monthly Operating Reports also contain information for periods which are shorter or otherwise different from those required in the Company's reports pursuant to the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended (the "Exchange Act"), and such information might not be indicative of the Company's financial condition or operating results for the period that would be reflected in the Company's financial statements or in its reports pursuant to the Exchange Act. Results set forth in the Monthly Operating Reports should not be viewed as indicative of future results.

Regions Bank and Export Development Canada are providing the DIP Facility. The DIP Financing, combined with the Company's cash from operations will provide funding for the Company's operations during the Chapter 11 process.

Also, as part of the first day motions handed down by the Bankruptcy Court, the Company was given the permission to pay pre-petition wages to all employees up to the \$4,925 limit per employee.

The Company is working on a strategy for its plan of reorganization.
