On May 31, 2016, Amyris, Inc. (the “**Company**”) announced that Nicholas Khadder, Senior Vice President, General Counsel and Corporate Secretary, had notified the Company on May 24, 2016, of his departure from the Company to pursue another opportunity. Mr. Khadder’s resignation is effective as of June 14, 2016, and Chris Jaenike, currently Assistant General Counsel, has been appointed as Interim General Counsel effective June 15, 2016.
