In our opinion, management's assertion that the Company complied with the requirements of subsections (b) and (c) of Rule 17f-2 of the Investment Company Act of 1940 as of September 30, 2015 with respect to securities reflected in the investment accounts of the Company is fairly stated, in all material respects.
