Item 5. Other Events

On November 25, 2002, Moody's Investor's Services (Moody's) issued a press release regarding the downgrade of credit ratings on various debt instruments issued by certain of Vectren Corporation's (Vectren) wholly owned subsidiaries, specifically Vectren Utility Holdings, Inc., Southern Indiana Gas and Electric Company and Indiana Gas Company, Inc. Moody's also confirmed the existing ratings on the debt securities of Vectren Capital Corporation and provided a stable outlook for all ratings. A copy of the press release is attached.

In connection with the "safe harbor" provisions of the Private Securities Litigation Reform Act of 1995, the Company is hereby filing cautionary statements identifying important factors that could cause actual results of the Company and its subsidiaries, including Indiana Gas Company, Inc. and Southern Indiana Gas and Electric Company, to differ materially from those projected in forward-looking statements of the Company and its subsidiaries made by, or on behalf of, the Company and its subsidiaries.
