The common shares were transferred in satisfaction of obligations owed pursuant to the Contingent Value Rights Agreements dated as of February 2008 (the "CVRs"), a form of which is included as Exhibit 99.2 to the Issuer's Schedule 14A filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission on February 1, 2008. Pursuant to the CVR Agreements, Terrapin Partners Venture Partnership was obligated to

- (1) pay (in the form of cash or the issuer's common shares) to CVR holders an amount per CVR by which the Anniversary Price (defined as the arithmetical average of the volume weighted average trading price of the Common Stock as reported by Bloomberg Professional Service for the period beginning 9:30 a.m., New York City time and ending at 4:00 p.m., New York City time for the 30 trading days prior to February 5, 2009) was less than \$10.50, up to a maximum of \$1.00 (the "CVR Payments").
- (Continued from footnote 1) The CVR Agreements provide that for purposes of determining the number of common shares required to settle the CVR Payments, the value of each common share shall equal the higher of the Anniversary Price or \$9.00. Accordingly, solely for purposes of computing the number of common shares required to settle the CVR Payments, each common share used to settle the CVR Payments has a deemed value of \$9.00 under the CVR Agreements.
- Jason Weiss and Nathan Leight are general partners of Terrapin Partners Venture Partnership, and they and/or their family trusts own interests in the Terrapin Partners Venture Partnership.
- This reflects a distribution of shares to the partners of Terrapin Partners Venture Partnership, including distributions to Jason Weiss, Nathan Leight, and/or their family trusts exempt under Rule 16a-13.
