(1) Transaction effected pursuant to Rule 10b5-1 trading plan adopted by the reporting person on March 8, 2013.

(2) The sale relates to shares underlying stock options that are scheduled to expire next month (May 3, 2015). The price of \$28.14 represents the weighted average of fifteen open-market sale transactions ranging in price from \$27.90 to \$28.28. The reporting person agrees to provide full information regarding the number of shares sold at each separate price paid if requested by the SEC staff, the Company or a security holder of the Company.
