Item 1.01 Entry into a Material Definitive Agreement.

On September 9, 2005, Williams-Sonoma, Inc. (the Company) amended its Reimbursement Agreements, dated July 1, 2005, with Bank of America, N.A., The Bank of New York and Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. (the Banks). These Reimbursement Agreements allow the Company to request the Banks to issue letters of credit on the Company s behalf in an aggregate amount of up to \$145,000,000. The amendments allow the Company to request the Banks to issue these letters of credit until September 9, 2006 and extend the latest expiration date for the letters of credit issued under the Reimbursement Agreements to February 6, 2007.
