Represents the conversion upon vesting of restricted stock units ("RSUs") into common stock. On July 15, 2015, the reporting person was
- (1) granted 8,333 RSUs that were previously reported on Table II of Form 4, which report was filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission on July 17, 2015.
- (2) These shares are owned directly by The Jury Bain Family Trust, of which the reporting person is a joint trustee with his spouse and a beneficiary.
- (3) These shares are owned directly by Jury Bain Superannuation Fund, a retirement fund of which the reporting person is a beneficiary.
- (4) Each RSU is the economic equivalent of one share of S&W Seed Company common stock. The closing price of SANW on October 1, 2015 was \$4.50.
- (5) The RSUs vest on the following schedule, assuming continued service with the Issuer on each vesting date: (i) 11,250 RSUs vested on October 1, 2015 (reported on this Form 4); the remaining 7,083 vest in 11 quarterly installments on the first day of each fiscal quarter,

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commencing on January 1, 2016 and continuing thereafter on the first day of each succeeding fiscal quarter through and including July 1, 2018. Of the quarterly vesting installments, 10 will vest an aggregate of 643 RSUs and the 11th installment will vest an aggregate of 653 RSUs. Vested shares will be delivered to the reporting person on the settlement date unless the Issuer elects to settle the RSUs in cash or a combination of shares and cash, at the Issuer's discretion.
