(4) Grant of shares of performance-based restricted stock under Farmer Mac's 2008 Omnibus Incentive Plan for no consideration. The shares will vest on March 31, 2016 if Farmer Mac meets certain performance objectives related to portfolio charge-offs and delinquencies, as specified in the related award agreement.

(5) Exercisable beginning March 31, 2014 with respect to 3,393 shares, beginning March 31, 2015 with respect to 3,393 shares, and beginning March 31, 2016 with respect to 3,394 shares.
